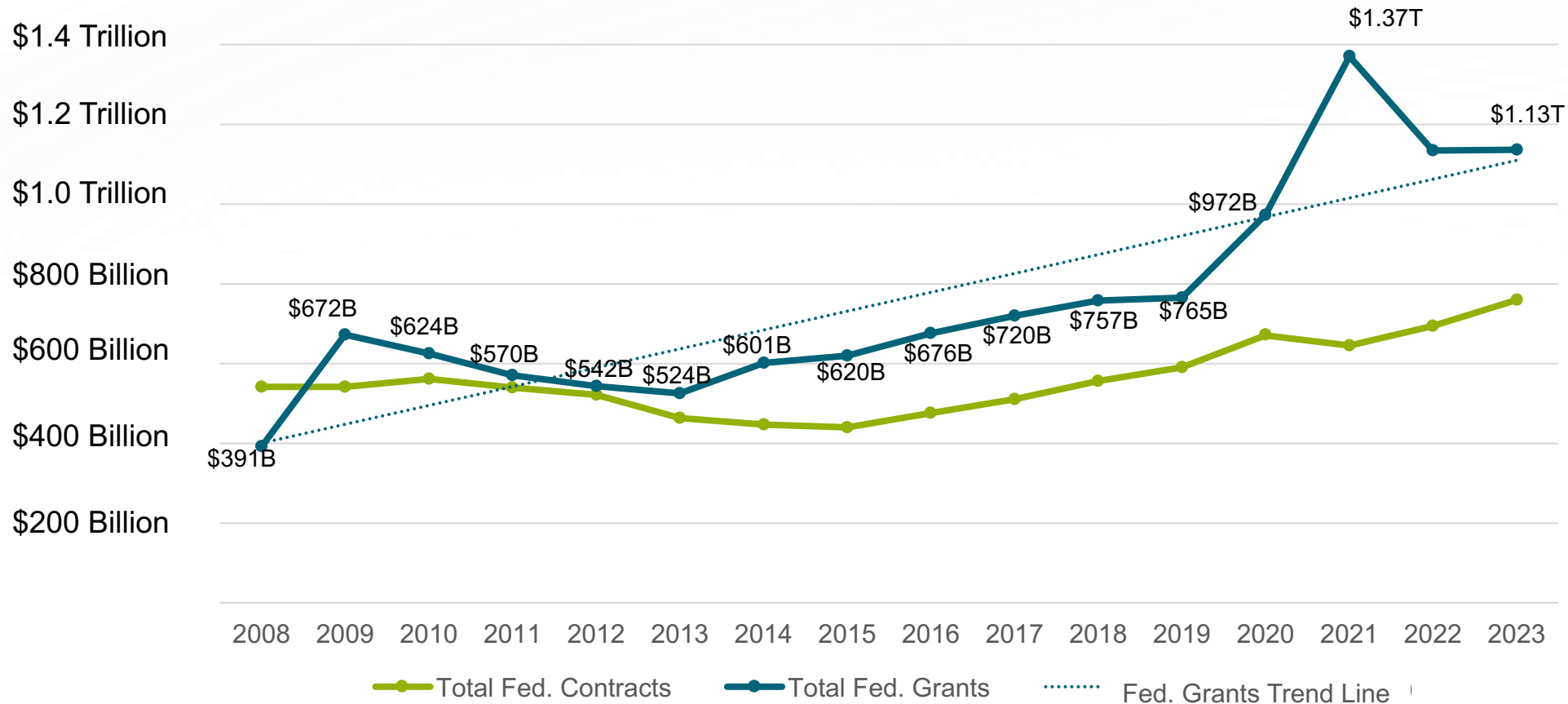

# Grants and Contracts Spending by Fiscal Year

Grants are one of the key ways the US government delivers services to the public.

Grants Obligations and Federal Contracts  
FY08 – FY23



Grants obligations are rising with an increase of +190% since 2008.

In 2023, Grants exceeded Contracts spending by \$377B.

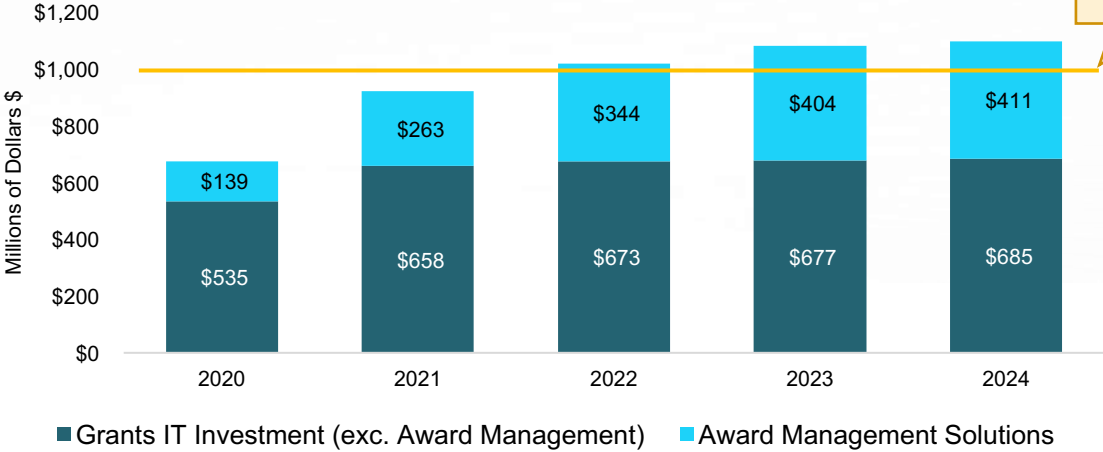

## Increasing Grants IT Investments\*



Over \$1B in total Grants IT investment in 2024.


Planned investment in Award Management Solutions **nearly tripled** from FY20 to FY24, **from \$139M to \$411M**. Total planned grants IT modernizations in FY24 value more than **\$1B**.

# Value of Centralized, Standard Solutions


## System Centralization

Consolidates/replaces multiple systems performing duplicate functions across an agency's departments and programs.

Eliminates duplicate spending for IT development and maintenance

## System Standardization

Replaces systems built on code-level agency/department customization .

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Democratizes cost of IT development and maintenance across all system customers
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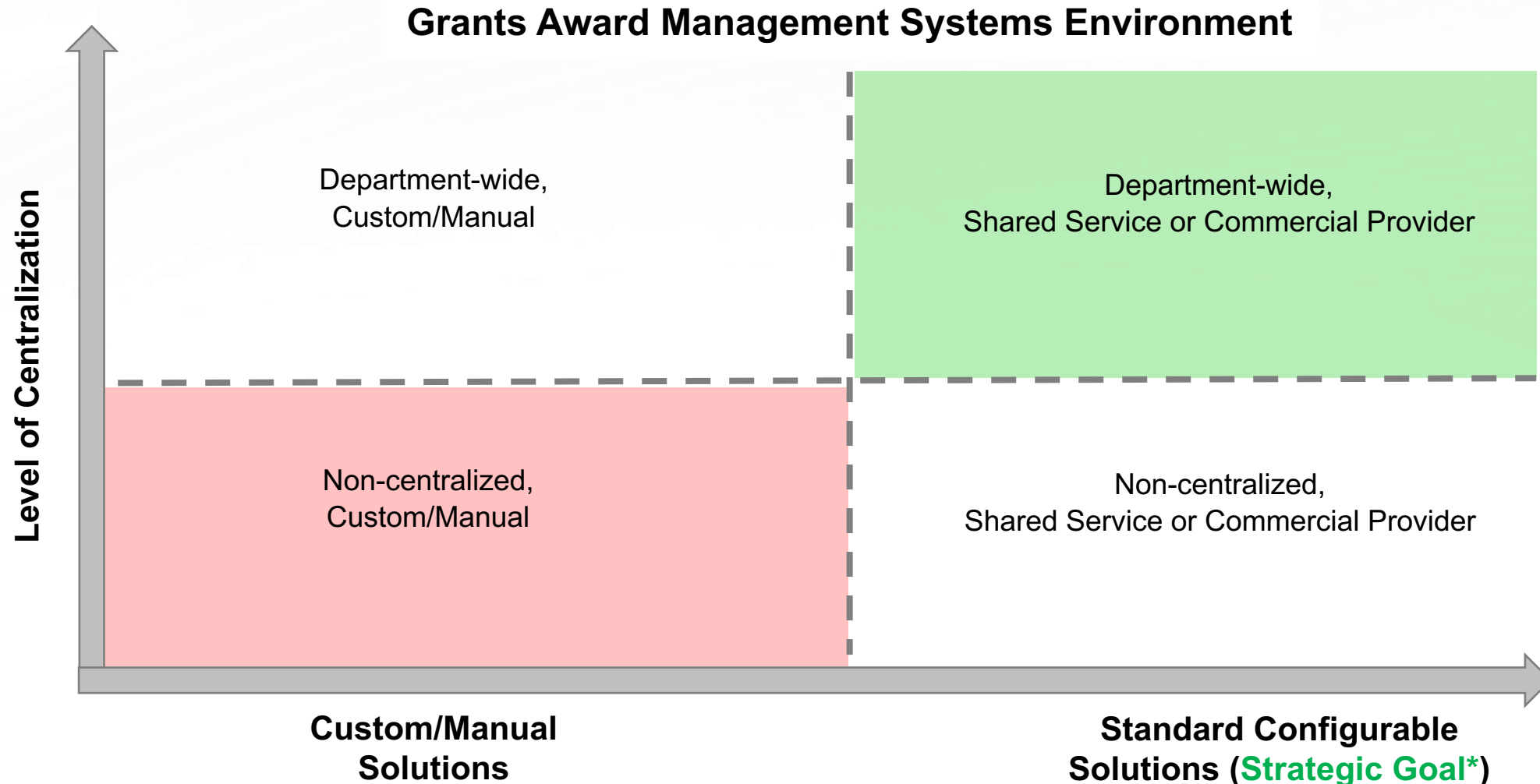
Eliminates need for system-by-system code revisions to accommodate new requirements:
 
  - IT Security requirements
  - Legal / Policy requirements
  - Business function requirements

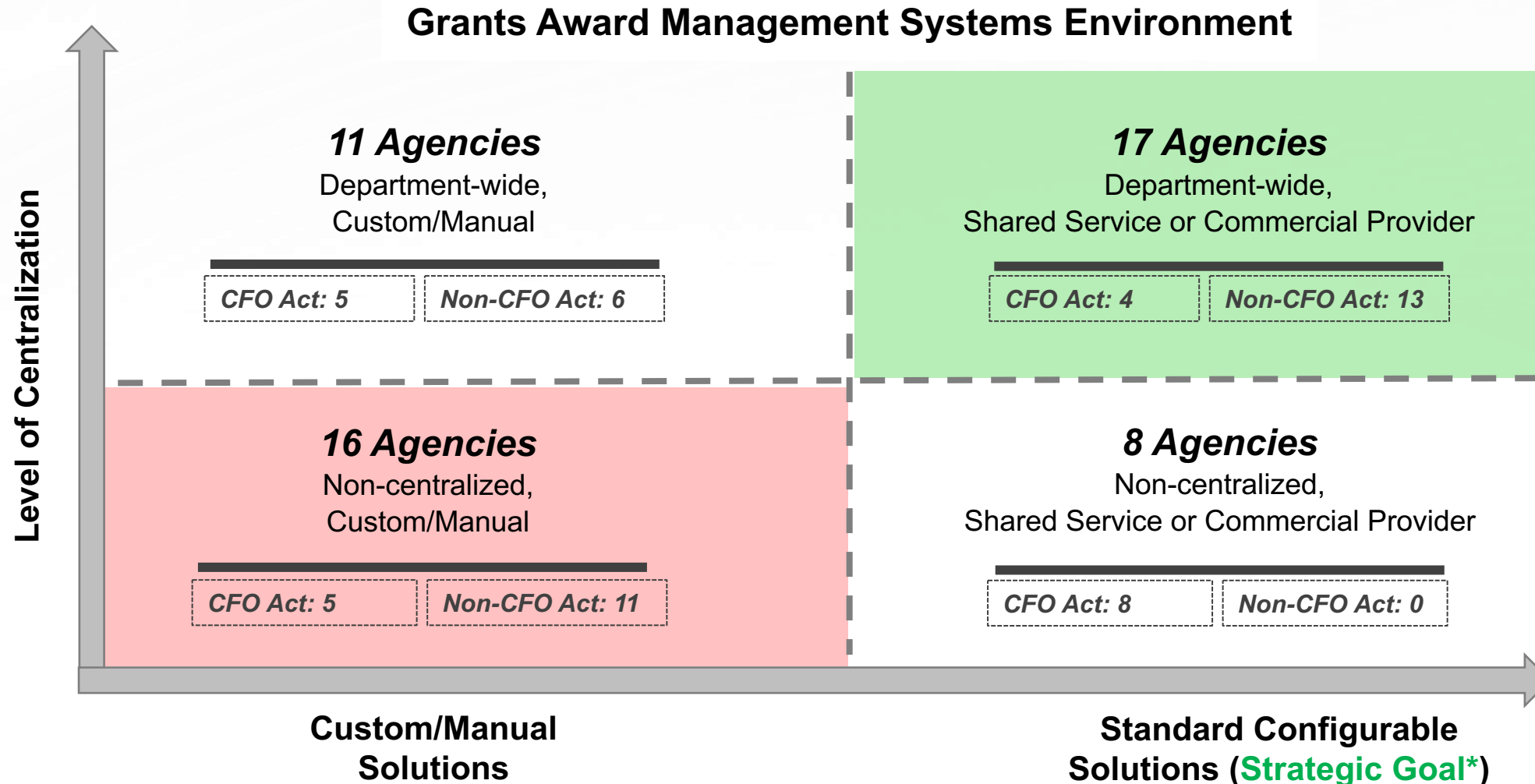
# System Standardization and Centralization

# System Standardization and Centralization

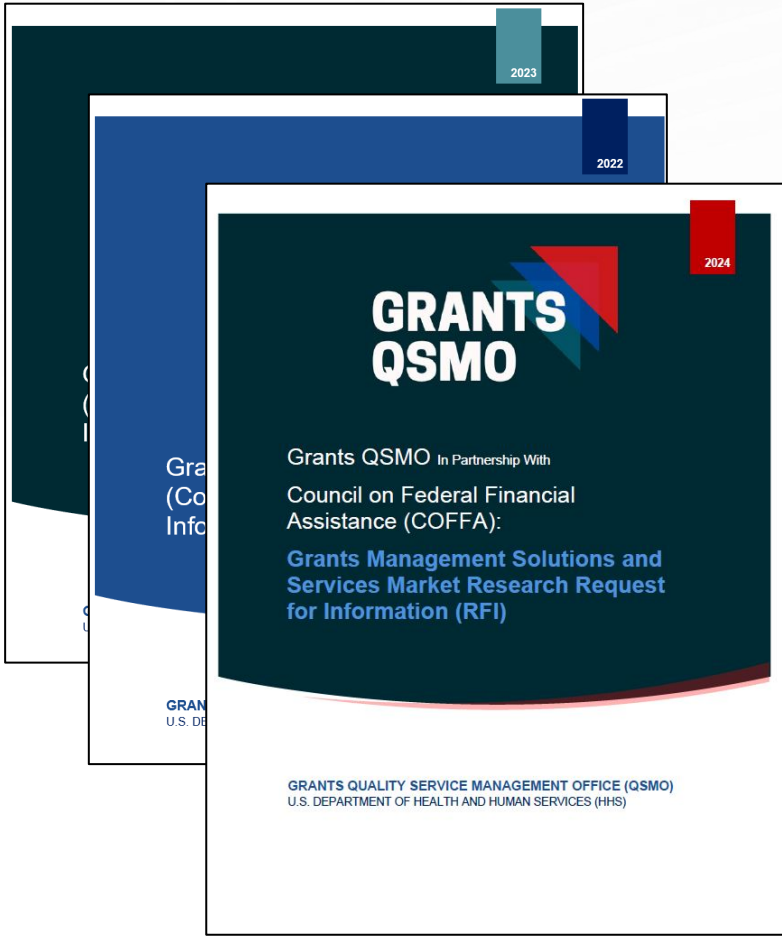
Opportunities exist to support the Grants QSMO goal of moving agencies toward standard, highly configurable solutions, ultimately supporting agency mission needs.

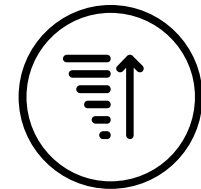

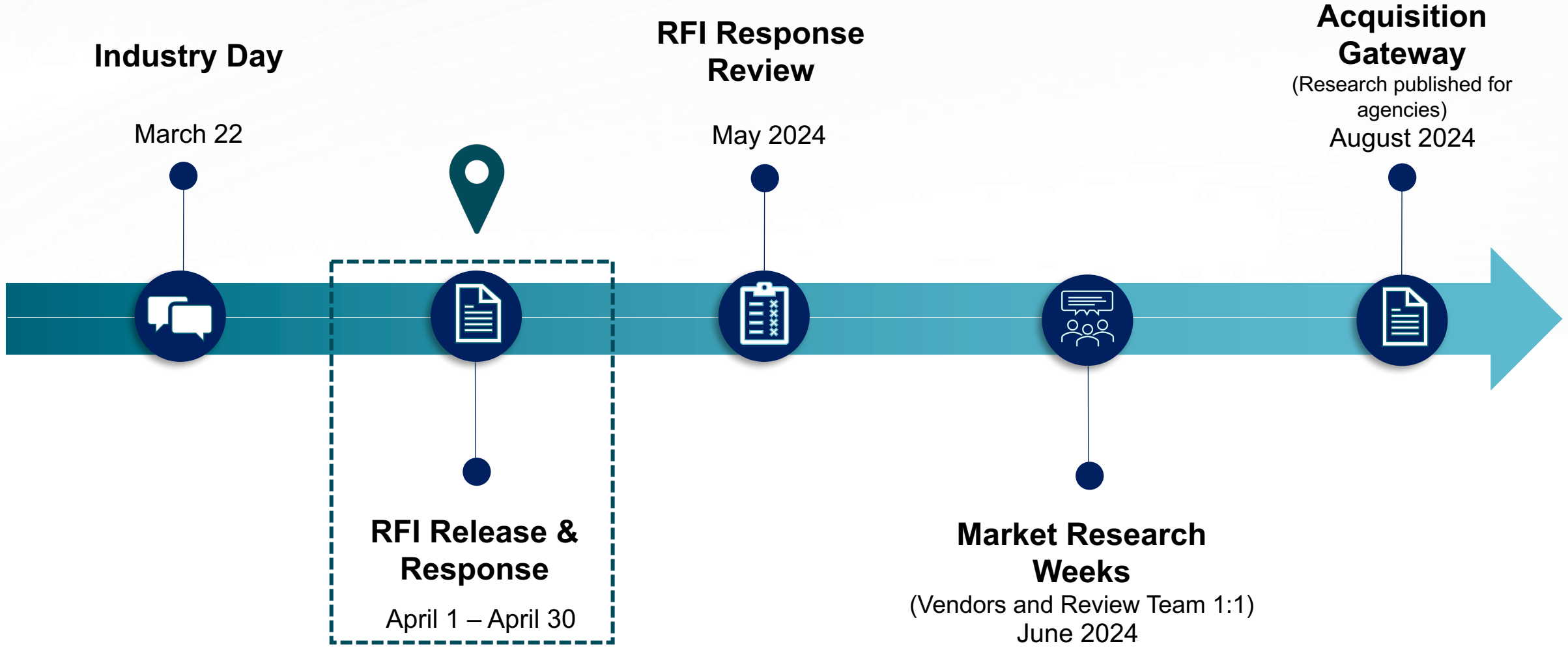

- Financial Assistance types supported: support for loans, direct payments, etc. in addition to grants and cooperative agreements



# Appendix

1. Solution is **Software-as-a-Service** with purpose-built functionality in core award management to receive and review grant applications, issue notices of award, process award modifications, produce reports on key award data, close out an award
2. **Out-of-the-box, highly configurable** grants management functionality does not require code changes for use by a federal agency
3. Processes are in place to collect and act on **customer and recipient user feedback** (prioritizes user-centered design)
4. Has **FedRAMP** certification or Federal **Authority to Operate** (ATO)
5. Can produce **FABS-compliant data extracts** that meet GSDM/USAspending.gov federal award reporting requirements
6. Proven **ability to scale to the Federal** government and manage federal financial assistance in accordance with 2CFR200
7. **Solution interfaces** with Grants.gov, SAM.gov, Federal Audit Clearinghouse (FAC.gov), and other relevant systems such as Login.gov or financial systems in use by federal agencies;
